SUMMER MINISTRY IS GROWING

What an amazing month of summer ministry! Every June, we focus heavily on a two-part summer program. First, we spend a week at Christian Youth in Action training camp where young men and women from across the state gather together to learn how to teach children about Jesus as well as how to grow in their own personal walk with the Lord. Then we return to the local area where these newly-trained summer missionaries lead 5-Day Clubs across the chapter.

This year has been our largest 5-Day Club outreach ever! Over 375 children attended one of 13 clubs led by two teams of young people. Twenty-one of these children made first-time professions of faith as a result. It is so wonderful to see the Holy Spirit working not only in the lives of the children in club but also in the hearts and minds of the seven summer missionaries leading clubs. Amazing growth and maturity!

One of the boys we met at a 5-Day Club in Smyrna said, "Thank you for coming to teach us about Jesus. I like really learning about Him instead of just watching a video about a Bible story." **Friends, be encouraged.** Children are hungry for truth and recognize it when they hear it!
